ORDER

27.08.2026

1. This Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Cancellation Petition has been filed by the petitioner-informant, namely, Krishna Prasad, under Section 483(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), challenging the impugned order dated 14.08.2024 passed by this Court (Sessions Judge, Patna) in A.B.P. No. 3102 of 2024, *Bir Bahadur Rai @ Bir Bahadur Yadav & Another vs. The State of Bihar*, whereby anticipatory bail was granted to the accused persons, namely, (1) Bir Bahadur Rai @ Bir Bahadur Yadav and (2) Avadesh Rai @ Avadesh Kumar Singh (now O.P. Nos. 2 and 3), in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No. 222 of 2024, registered under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (IPC), as well as Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

2. Today, learned counsel for Opposite Party Nos. 2 and 3 appeared before this Court.

3. The case was called out repeatedly, but no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner. From perusal of the order-sheets, it appears that on 06.06.2026,

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07.07.2026, 20.07.2026, 24.02.2026, 19.03.2026, 15.04.2026, 25.11.2026 as well as on subsequent dates, despite repeated calls, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that petitioner has no interest to contest this case on merit. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous (Bail Cancellation) Petition is liable to be dismissed for non-appearance of the petitioner.

4. It is, therefore, ordered that this Criminal Misc.(Bail Cancellation) petition is **dismissed** due to **continuous non-appearance** on behalf of the petitioner.
