Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This Probate Case has been filed under Section 276 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925 for grant of probate with respect to the Will dated 21.09.2022 of the Estate of Late Mostt. Sushila Devi in favour of the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner filed a petition dated 13.03.2026 and submitted that inadvertently, "Rs.20,00,000/-" has been mentioned as the value of the movable and immovable property of the deceased in Annexure-A at Page-9 of the plaint instead of "Rs.30,00,000/-". Accordingly, prayed to allow this petition.

Perused the record and the petition for correction in the plaint. From perusal of the plaint of the record, it appears that the amendment sought for will not change the nature of this probate case. The same will not prejudice the other side and the same is simple in nature.

Having considered the facts mentioned in the amendment petition and in the interest of justice, the amendment petition is **allowed**. Learned Counsel for the petitioner is directed to carry out the necessary amendments with the assistance of Office Clerk.
