ORDER

13.05.2026 1. Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused-petitioner, namely, **Kaushal Kumar** who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Jakkanpur P.S Case No. 765/2025** registered U/S- 85, 351(2), 352, & 3(5) of B.N.S. which is pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M-VIII Patna has been moved by his learned counsel. The Ld. A.P.P for the State as well as Ld. Counsel on behalf of the informant appeared before the court. Case diary is available on record.

2. The case of the prosecution in brief, is that informant filed a written complaint before the SHO Jankkanpur, alleging therein that her husband Kaushal Kumar always gave beatings to her. Her father-in-law Gauri Shankar Prasad, mother-in-law Sushila Devi and brother-in-law Vikash Kumar used to instigate him for giving beatings to her. Marriage of the informant was solemnized about six years ago with accused-petitioner Kaushal Kumar, and three children were born out of the said wedlock.

Further alleged that on 24.09.2025 her husband Kaushal Kumar came, armed with an iron rod and gave beatings to her and also tried to strangulate her neck. Further alleged her husband used to compel her to bring Rs.10 lakh from her parents. On non-fulfillment of the same he always physically assaulted the informant.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. Further submits that informant along with her son had left the matrimonial home voluntarily with all the gold ornaments gifted by the petitioner during marriage and left her two daughters with the petitioner. Further submits that informant used to demand entire income from her husband and asked him not to look after his parents, when the petitioner objected it, the informant behaved in cruel, abusive and aggressive manner and used to quarrel with the petitioner. Further submits that allegations against the petitioner are general and omnibus. Further submits that petitioner has not moved anticipatory bail petition or regular bail petition either

13.05.2026 before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court,Patna. Further submits that petitioner has one criminal antecedent. Further submits that petitioner is ready to furnish the bail bonds to the satisfaction of the court, hence prayed for anticipatory bail.

4. On the other hand the learned Addl. P.P. for the State as well as Ld. Counsel on behalf of the informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

5. Heard. Record as well as case diary perused. Petitioner is husband of the informant. Allegations against the petitioner is that he used to give beatings and even did not provide food to informant. On 24.09.2025 the accused-petitioner gave beatings to the informant with iron rod and also tried to strangulate her. On 24.09.2025 informant was medically treated at Primary Health Centre Gardanibagh, injury report is annexed with the case diary shows abrasion over right cheek, over right waist and multiple small abrasion over back. Informant was further referred to the PMCH, Patna for further treatment and discharged on 26.09.2026. It is also alleged that petitioner used to demand Rs. 10 Lakhs from the informant.

6. Considering the above mentioned facts and circumstances and allegations against the petitioner, this court does not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence the prayer for bail of the petitioner, namely, **Kaushal Kumar**, is hereby **rejected**.

It is however, clarified that nothing expression herein above shall tantamount to an expression of opinion of merits of the case.
