1. This regular bail application has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner **Chanchal Devi** who is in judicial custody since 11.02.2026, in connection with **Rupaspur P.S. Case No.93/2026** dated 11.02.2026, instituted for an offence under Sections 8(c), 21(b) of NDPS Act and section 111 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
2. Heard Sri Ashish Kumar, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha, Learned Spl. PP on behalf of the State.
3. The allegation against the accused persons is that on 10.06.2026, the police raided Patliputra Station Road and apprehended the petitioner Chanchal Devi along with co-accused persons Veer Kumar and Savitri Devi. On search, 09 plastic containers containing heroine like substance weighing total 102.88 grams were recovered, out of which 33.12 grams was allegedly recovered from the possession of the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent, committed no offence and has no criminal antecedent. It was further submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 11.02.2026. On these grounds, prayed for privilege of regular bail.
5. On the other hand, learned Special Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner and submitted that 09 plastic containers containing heroine like substance weighing total 102.88 grams were recovered

from the possession of the accused persons, out of which 33.12 grams was allegedly recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It was next submitted that investigation is ongoing and charge sheet is yet to be submitted against this petitioner. The allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the privilege of regular bail.

6. Considering the nature of accusation; quantum of recovery, i.e. 09 plastic containers containing heroine like substance weighing total 102.88 grams were recovered from the possession of the accused persons, out of which 33.12 grams was allegedly recovered from the possession of the petitioner, which falls beyond the category of small quantity as per Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985; submissions of learned Special Public Prosecutor; investigation is ongoing and charge-sheet is yet to be submitted, this Court is of the opinion that it is not a fit case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.
7. Accordingly, this regular bail application filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Chanchal Devi** is hereby **rejected**.
