1. This regular bail application has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner **Alagu Mukhiya**, who is in judicial custody since 24.10.2025, in connection with **DRI Patna Unit Case No.21/2025-26** dated 24.10.2025, instituted for an offence under Sections 20(b)(ii)(c), 23 & 29 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard Sri Umesh Kumar, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha, Learned Spl. PP on behalf of the State.
3. The allegation against the petitioner is that on 23.10.2025 the officers of DRI apprehended the petitioner and recovered 11.500 Kg ganja.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent, committed no offence and has no criminal antecedent. It was further submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 24.10.2025. On these grounds, prayed for privilege of regular bail.
5. On the other hand, learned Special Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner and submitted that 11.500 Kg of ganja was recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It was next submitted that investigation is ongoing and charge sheet is yet to be submitted against this petitioner. The allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the privilege of regular bail.
6. Considering the nature of accusation; quantum of recovery, i.e. 11.500 Kg

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ganja from the possession of the petitioner, which falls beyond the category of small quantity as per Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985; submissions of learned Special Public Prosecutor; investigation is ongoing and charge-sheet is yet to be submitted, this Court is of the opinion that it is not a fit case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this regular bail application filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Alagu Mukhiya** is hereby **rejected**.
