- 1.** This regular bail application has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner **Vikash Kumar**, who is in custody since 14.02.2026, in connection with **Nadi P.S. Case No. 57/2026** dated 14.02.2026, registered under Sections 8/20(b), 8(c), 21(b) of NDPS Act.
- 2.** Heard Sri Shashikant Kumar, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha, Learned Spl. PP on behalf of the State.
- 3.** The allegation against the petitioner is that in total 14.82 grams of smack and 26.22 grams of ganja were recovered from the gumti of the petitioner.
- 4.** Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent, committed no offence and has been falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner no criminal antecedent. It was next submitted that the mandatory provisions of NDPS Act has not been complied by the police. The petitioner is in custody since 14.02.2026. On these grounds, prayed for privilege of regular bail.
- 5.** On the other hand, learned Special Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner and submitted that total 14.82 grams of smack and 26.22 grams of ganja were recovered from the gumti of the petitioner. It was next submitted that investigation is ongoing and charge sheet is yet to be submitted against this petitioner. The allegation against the petitioner is serious in nature. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the privilege of regular bail.

- 6.** Considering the nature of accusation; quantum of recovery, i.e. total 14.82 grams of smack and 26.22 grams of ganja were recovered from the gumti of the petitioner, which falls beyond the category of small quantity as per Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985; submissions of learned Special Public Prosecutor; investigation is ongoing and charge-sheet is yet to be submitted, this Court is of the opinion that it is not a fit case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.
- 7.** Accordingly, this regular bail application filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Vikash Kumar**, is hereby **rejected**.
