**ORDER**

**16.03.2026**

1. Regular bail petition filed on behalf of accused-petitioner, namely, **Satyendra Prasad** who is in custody since 07.02.2026 in connection with **Ram Krishna Nagar P.S Case No. 115 of 2026** registered under Sections-126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2) 75, 76 of B.N.S. which is pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C, Patna has been moved by his learned counsel. Learned A.P.P. for the State as well as Ld. Counsel of the informant appeared. Case diary is available on the record.

2. The case of the prosecution in short, is that informant gave typed complaint before the SHO P.S Ram Krishna Nagar alleging therein that on 05.02.2026 at about 3:30 P.M informant was sitting at his house along with his family members, accused-persons namely Saytendra Prasad, Sanjeev Kumar and wife of the petitioner along with four unknown persons entered into the house of informant, abused and assaulted him with an iron rod, causing head injury. They also threatened to kill him.

Further alleged that accused-persons damaged the railing of staircase, assaulted other family members, snatched ear-rings of the informant's family member and also attempted to outrage the modesty of his daughter-in-law. On the basis of these allegations against the petitioner present F.I.R was registered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence and falsely implicated in the present case due to previous enmity and local dispute between the parties. Further submits that allegations made in F.I.R are general and omnibus in nature, no specific overt act attracting the essential ingredients of the serious offences alleged has been attributed specifically to the petitioner. Further submits that petitioner is not previously involved in any criminal cases. Further submits that petitioner is in judicial custody since 07.02.2026. Further submits that petitioner has not moved anticipatory bail petition or regular bail petition either

**16.03.2026** before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. Further submits that petitioner is ready to furnish the bail bonds to the satisfaction of the court, hence prayed for regular bail.

4. On the other hand, the learned Addl. P.P. for the State as well as Ld. Counsel of the informant strongly opposed the prayer of regular bail petition.

5. Ld. Counsel of the informant submits that petitioner is a habitual offender and earlier also on 12.07.2025 the petitioner along with his son assaulted the son of the informant. Further submits that petitioner is frequently harassing the informant and his family members, with malafide intention. Further submits that informant was given Sanha on 12.07.2025 to SHO Ram Krishna Nagar. Further submits that informant and her daughter-in-law have received injury and treated in Emergency ward of N.M.C.H Patna.

6. Heard. Record as well as case diary perused. On perusal it transpires that petitioner is in judicial custody since 07.02.2026 . From perusal of injury report of two injured persons namely Gudiya Kumari and Ramji Prasad transpires that injuries opined by the doctor are simple in nature. Allegations levelled against the petitioner are general and omnibus in nature. From perusal of Para 35 of the case diary transpires that petitioner is not previously involved in any criminal case. Further co-accused namely Sanjeev Kumar and Babita Devi were released on anticipatory bail by this court vide A.B.P no. 682/26 dt. 26.02.2026.

7. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances the petitioner namely, **Satyendra Prasad** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below subject to the condition :-

- i) Petitioner shall appear physically before the trial court on each and every date till framing of charge.
- ii) Petitioner shall not induce, threat or promise to any witness who are acquainted with the facts.
- iii) Petitioner shall co-operate in trial before the court.
- iv) Petitioner shall file a separate undertaking that he shall not commit any offence in future.

- v) One of the bailor shall be family member/close relative of the petitioner.
- vi) Petitioner is directed to maintain peace and harmony in the society.  
It is however, clarified that nothing expression herein above shall tantamount to an expression of opinion of merits of the case.
