Conducting the petition the learned counsel of the accused petitioner namely <b>Indrdeo Singh</b> submitted that no bail petition of any sort was earlier filed in this court or any higher court. It was submitted that the petitioner had no criminal antecedent. It was submitted that petitioner was quite innocent and he had committed no offence. It was submitted that petitioner had been falsely implicated in this case. It was further submitted that the said truck was passing the gate and half of truck body was passed the gate in the meantime gate-man was closing the gate without seeing the vehicle and boom had touched with the back portion of the truck. It was further submitted that petitioner was track owner – cum- driver of the truck bearing registration No. WB19L-3250. It was further submitted that petitioner had ready to pay the estimated damage amount Rs. 3000/-. It was also submitted that the petitioner was ready to comply all the directions of the court and cooperate in trial. The Ld. Counsel prayed to allow the petition and enlarged the petitioner on bail.</li><li>2. The Ld. APP objected the petition and prayed to reject it.</li><li>3. Perused the case record.</li><li>4. The petitioner has been made accused in this case for offence u/s 160(2) of Railway Act 1989. vide RPF Biharsharif PS Case No.-69/2026.</li><li>5. Prosecution case according to the complainant in brief is that on 21.01.2026 at about 03:00 PM a truck WB19L3250 negligently drove the vehicle and damaged the western boom of the level crossing gate at LC gate 14C in Rajgir Tilaiya Rail Block. The damage to the Railway property was estimated about Rs. 3,000/-.</li><li>6. Petitioner claims to be owner and driver of the truck and his ready to pay estimated damage Rs. 3,000/- vehicle.</li></ol>

7. In the result, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner namely **Indrdeo Singh**, is hereby, allowed and following orders is passed.

1. In the event of arrest or surrender within one month of the receipt/production of this order the petitioner is directed to be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount subject to an undertaking u/s 482(2) of the BNSS to the satisfaction of the learned jurisdictional court concerned and the payment of Rs. 3,000/- at or prior to the filing of the bail bond.

8. It is made clear that this order has no bearing on the merits of the case.
