- 1.** This regular bail application has been filed on behalf of accused-petitioner **Pawan Kumar Yadav**, who is in custody since 22.02.2026, in connection with **Maner P.S. Case No.163/2026** dated 22.02.2026, registered under Sections 8(c), 20(b), (ii), 21(b), 22(c) of NDPS Act.
- 2.** Heard Sri Mahesh Kumar, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha, Learned Spl. PP on behalf of the State.
- 3.** The allegation against the petitioner is that total 13.31 grams of smack from the possession of the petitioner as well as co-accused Bali Pandit. Further, on search of petitioner's house 5.70 grams of smack, 8.96 grams of ganja and cash worth Rs.2,61,200/- were also recovered.
- 4.** Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent, committed no offence and has been falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner no criminal antecedent in which he is on bail. The petitioner is in custody since 22.02.2026. On these grounds, prayed for privilege of regular bail.
- 5.** On the other hand, learned Special Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner and submitted that 13.31 grams of smack from the possession of the petitioner as well as co-accused Bali Pandit and on further search of petitioner's house, 5.70 grams of smack, 8.96 grams of ganja and cash worth Rs.2,61,200/- were also recovered. It was next submitted that investigation is ongoing and charge sheet is yet to be submitted against this petitioner. The allegation against the petitioner is

serious in nature. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the privilege of regular bail.

6. Considering the nature of accusation; 13.31 grams of smack from the possession of the petitioner as well as co-accused Bali Pandit and on further search of petitioner's house 5.70 grams of smack, 8.96 grams of ganja and cash worth Rs.2,61,200/- were also recovered, which falls beyond the category of small quantity as per Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985; submissions of learned Special Public Prosecutor; investigation is ongoing and charge-sheet is yet to be submitted, this Court is of the opinion that it is not a fit case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.
7. Accordingly, this regular bail application filed on behalf of the petitioner namely **Pawan Kumar Yadav** is hereby **rejected**.
