O R D E R

The present petition had been filed by Avinash Kumar, Son of Arvind Kumar, District-Nalanda, Bihar Sharif under section 7 and Section 9 of the Guardians and Wards Act with Section 13 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, for the custody of child. The petitioner appeared today and filed a petition to withdraw of this case.

The petitioner along with his learned counsel had appeared before the court today and has pressed her withdrawal petition and has deposed that he no longer intends to press this guardianship case any further at this stage. No prejudice shall be caused to respondent No. 1 by allowing this withdrawal and the petitioner reserves the right to file a fresh application in the future if circumstances so warrants. Hence, he prayed to withdraw this matrimonial petition with due permission of this court.
