1. The **petitioners, who are real brothers**, apprehend arrest in connection with **Ram Krishna Nagar P.S. Case No. 246 of 2026**, registered under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 190, 191(2), 303(2), and 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS).
2. As per the prosecution's version, narrated by the informant Sachin Kumar, on 12.03.2026 at about 4:00 AM, he was returning home in his car when Ganesh DJ had parked a DJ trolley in the middle of the road near Dhelvan Post Office. On being asked to remove the vehicle, he refused. It is alleged that the petitioners, along with co-accused Dinesh Kumar, Bunty Kumar, and three unidentified persons, assaulted the informant and his brother with lathis, sticks, and belts, causing head injuries. Further, the accused allegedly snatched his gold chain and locket before fleeing. It is also alleged that co-accused Bunty Kumar threatened to abduct him within a month and forcibly took away two machines from his warehouse.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the only non-bailable offence alleged is under Section 303(2) of the BNS, which carries a maximum punishment of five years imprisonment and is triable by a Magistrate. He further contends that the allegations of assault and snatching are vague and omnibus in nature, and that the petitioners have been falsely implicated due to rivalry in the DJ service business. Learned counsel candidly admits that petitioner No.1 has one prior criminal antecedent Ram Krishna Nagar P.S. Case No. 841/2023 under the Excise Act, while petitioner No.2 is implicated in an old case, Ram Krishna Nagar P.S. Case No. 772/2019, under Section 379 and allied provisions of the IPC.
4. For a better appreciation of the anticipatory bail application, the

office is directed to **requisition the case diary** and the criminal antecedents of the petitioners from the Investigating Officer.

5. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks interim protection from arrest.
6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case; the nature of the offences, the punishment prescribed upon conviction; nature of accusation against the petitioners being general and omnibus in nature; and the submissions made on behalf of the petitioners, ***interim protection from arrest is granted to the petitioners until the next date*** in connection with **Ram Krishna Nagar P.S. Case No. 246 of 2026**. The petitioners are, however, directed to cooperate with the Investigating Officer and remain available whenever required by the police.
7. Re-notify this case on 21.05.2026.
