ORDER

02.04.2026

1. The present Criminal Appeal has been preferred by the appellant- accused namely- **Upendra Kumar** against the impugned judgment and order of conviction and sentence dated 06.01.2026 passed by Ms. Aparajita Anand, learned J.M. 1st Class, Patna in G.R. Case No. 3831/2011 arising out of Kotwali P.S. Case No.404/2011, whereby the Learned Trial Court convicted the sole appellant under Section 279 of the IPC and sentenced him to undergo for two months simple imprisonment and with a fine of Rs. 500/-(five hundred) and in case of default liable for simple imprisonment of 15 (fifteen) days.
2. The learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the petitioner was granted bail by the learned trial court on the same day of judgment dated 06.01.2026 for filing the instant criminal appeal. Further submitted that while hearing on admission on previous date 27.02.2026, the petitioner could not pray for bail in absence of trial court record and also the appellant himself did not produce the certified copy of bail order.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor for the State has raised no objection.
4. As per submission of learned counsel for the appellant and from perusal of trial court record it appears that appellant Upendra Kumar had already granted provisional bail vide order dated 06.01.2026. Under the circumstances the bail petition of appellant-accused Upendra Kumar is hereby **allowed** and appellant-accused is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each of the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
5. Re-list on 05.05.2026 for hearing.
