the informant's mother's vehicle, which was never actually handed over to the petitioner. Thus, the matter is essentially civil in nature, though the informant has attempted to give it a criminal colour. Counsel also highlights the petitioner's clean antecedent.

- 5.** Ld. Public Prosecutor ably assisted by Ld. Counsel for informant opposes the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. He submits that the car alleged to be rented to the petitioner belongs to the informant's mother and in that regard an agreement was executed between the informant's mother and the petitioner. However he failed to pay the payment towards rent of the car and the cheques issued in that regard were dishonoured.
- 6.** Considering the facts and circumstances of the case; the nature of the alleged offences, the severity of punishment; the submissions of learned counsel more particularly that the matter is essentially civil in nature; and the petitioner's unblemished antecedent, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the above-named petitioner is **allowed**. It is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the above-named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
