1. The present application for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the **accused-petitioner, Ravi Kumar**, who has been in judicial custody since 03.05.2026, in connection with **Agamkuan P.S. Case No. 448/2026** dated 02.05.2026, registered under **Sections 8/20(b)(ii)(B) of the NDPS Act**.
2. Heard Sri Vijay Kumar Sinha, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner, and Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha, learned Special Public Prosecutor for the State on 26.05.2026. The matter was thereafter fixed for order on 29.05.2026. However, as the Court was not available on the said date, the case was adjourned for today. Since arguments on behalf of both sides have already been concluded, the order is being pronounced today.
3. The allegation as per prosecution in brief, is that on 02.05.2026 at about 13:30 hours, acting on secret information, a raiding team reached near Nandlal Chapra More. On seeing the police, the petitioner attempted to flee but was apprehended. A search led to the recovery of 10.230 kilograms of ganja from a bag carried on his back. During interrogation, he disclosed that the contraband was intended to be delivered to co-accused Anshu Baba at a cloth shop in Ramdayalu, Muzaffarpur.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent, has no prior criminal record, and has been falsely implicated with mala fide intent. It was further submitted that nothing incriminating was recovered from his possession and that the mandatory provisions of the NDPS Act were not duly complied with

by the investigating agency. The petitioner has remained in custody since 03.05.2026, and on these grounds, a prayer was made for grant of regular bail.

5. *Per contra*, learned Special Public Prosecutor opposed the bail plea, contending that the recovery of 10.230 kilograms of ganja exceeds the threshold of small quantity under the NDPS Act. He further submitted that the investigation is still in progress and the charge sheet is yet to be filed. In view of the seriousness of the allegations, it was urged that the petitioner is not entitled to regular bail.
6. Having regard to the nature of the accusation; the quantum of recovery of **10.230 kilograms of ganja**, which far exceeds the threshold of small quantity under the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act; the submissions advanced by the learned Special Public Prosecutor; and the fact that investigation is ongoing with charge sheet yet to be filed; this Court is of the view that the present case does not warrant grant of regular bail.
7. Accordingly, the application for regular bail filed on behalf of the **petitioner, Ravi Kumar**, stands **rejected**.
