ORDER

03.06.2026

1. The present criminal miscellaneous application has been filed by the **petitioner, Shashi Bhushan Sinha**, under Section 408 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, corresponding to Section 448 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), seeking transfer of **ABP No. 2048/2026, arising out of Complaint Case No. 275(C)/2019**, presently pending before the Court of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-13th, Patna to any other court for hearing and disposal.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Public Prosecutor for the State, and have also taken into consideration the report submitted by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-13th, Patna.
3. A report had earlier been requisitioned from the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-13th, Patna, which is available on record.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the learned Additional Sessions Judge-13th, Patna, is not in a position to call for the records of the complaint case from the Court of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-8th, Patna.
5. Per contra, the learned Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer for transfer, submitting

that the grounds advanced appears to be unfounded to justify such relief.

6. In the report, the learned Additional Sessions Judge-13th, Patna, clarified that the case was received on transfer from the Court of the learned Sessions Judge, Patna, with the next scheduled date being 16.05.2026. It was further noted that the Trial Court Records (TCR) was duly called for by order dated 16.05.2026, and the matter was fixed for hearing on 08.06.2026.
7. In view of the facts and circumstances, and upon consideration of the report submitted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-13th, Patna, it is clear that the ground urged by the petitioner is wholly untenable. The Trial Court Record has already been requisitioned by the said Court vide order dated 16.05.2026. Consequently, the contention advanced on behalf of the petitioner that the Court is unable to call for the records of Complaint Case No. 275(C)/2019, stands without merit.
8. Accordingly, the present application is **dismissed**.
