1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. This Probate Case has been filed under Section 276 of the Indian Succession Act for grant of probate with respect to the Will dated 23.02.2018 of the Estate of Late Dharmshila Devi in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner filed a petition dated 27.11.2024 and submitted that the original Will dated 23.02.2018 was in custody of Late Dharmshila Devi and after her death original will is not traceable by the petitioner due to which he is unable to file the same before this Court. Accordingly, prayed to direct the Sheristedar to accept the certified copy of the deed of Will dated 23.02.2018.
