Summon/Bailable warrant issued to accused received back unserved. Notice through Summon/Bailable warrant have been issued to accused many times but the same were either not received back or received back unserved and thus, the presence of the accused could not be secured due to one reason or the other despite issuing several processes. The present challan has been pending for quite some time, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the same pending. Moreover, as per the instructions of the Hon'ble High Court issued vide letter no.22963.9az.II(2), dated 17.08.2007 and considering the fact and circumstances of the present case, the proceedings are **ordered to be closed under Section 258 Cr.P.C.** Further, if the accused appears anytime before the court for getting his challan disposed of, the same would be made re-open for its disposal in accordance with law. Consequently, challan be consigned to record room after due compliance with red ink note that the same be not destroyed and be put up again as and when accused appears before the Court and applies for disposal of the Challan.
