

Anticipatory Bail Petition No.2380 of 2026.

ORDER

1. The **petitioner, Manish Ranjan Kumar @ Munna Singh**, seeks anticipatory bail in connection with **Shastri Nagar P.S. Case No. 815 of 2025**, registered under Sections 303(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS).

3. The prosecution case, as narrated by the informant Tanya Priya, is that she operated a food cart near the Patna High Court. Following a Court order directing clearance of the area, she removed her cart but was unable to find a suitable location despite searching for several days. It is alleged that the petitioner, Munna Ji of Shivpuri, offered her space near his residence for a monthly rent of ₹1,500. Consequently, from 26.03.2025, she parked her food cart at the said location and regularly paid rent to the petitioner and his son through their mobile numbers. The informant further claims that on 15th September, she discovered her food cart missing. Upon inquiry, the petitioner allegedly informed her that he had sold the cart and defiantly challenged her to take any action she wished. It is alleged that the sale was made without her consent or authorization. She also asserts that the cart contained several valuable items, estimating the total worth of the cart and its contents at ₹4,00,000-₹5,00,000.

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park her food cart on the road in front of the apartment, which was objected to by the petitioner and other residents. Learned counsel argues that the present case has been instituted maliciously as a retaliatory measure. He candidly acknowledges that the petitioner has one prior criminal antecedent, which is an old one i.e., Shastri Nagar P.S. Case No. 343/2016 instituted under Sections 323, 341, 34 IPC and Section 53 of the Bihar Excise Amendment Act, which is bailable in nature and was lodged by the petitioner's wife.

5. Learned Public Prosecutor opposes the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, he is not in a position to controvert the submissions advanced on behalf of petitioner. Also, no other incriminating material has been brought on record by the Investigating Officer against the petitioner.
6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case; the nature of the offences, prescribed punishment upon conviction; the rival submissions advanced on behalf of learned counsel for the parties, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail of the above-named petitioner is **allowed**. It is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the above-named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
