ORDER

05.07.2025

1. The instant criminal revision application has been preferred on behalf of Priyanka Kumari, arraying the State of Bihar as Opposite Party No. 1 and the complainant in Complaint Case No. 491(C)/2023, namely Ms. Anvita Anand, as Opposite Party No. 2. The petitioner seeks to assail the order dated 24.05.2023 passed by the Court of Ms. Tanvi Tejaswita, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Patna, whereby a prima facie case has been found to exist for offences punishable under Sections 323, 504, and 506 of the Indian Penal Code against the petitioner as well as co-accused persons —namely, Shyam Kumar Singh, Chandan Kumar, Tituraj Tufani, and Pooja Kumari.
2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned In-charge Public Prosecutor representing the State, and perused the documents annexed to the present criminal revision application.
3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned order dated 24.05.2023, whereby a prima facie case has been found against the petitioner, notably, the petitioner is a serving Judicial Officer against whom processes could not have been validly issued without

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obtaining prior sanction from the competent authority. It is further submitted that, by order dated 03.06.2025, a bailable warrant of arrest has also been issued against the petitioner.

4. In view of the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the operation of the order dated 03.06.2025, whereby a bailable warrant of arrest has been issued against the petitioner, shall **remain stayed**. Further proceedings in Complaint Case No. 491(C)/2023 shall also **remain stayed until further orders**.
5. Let the records of the Trial Court be requisitioned.
6. Re-list this matter on 19.07.2025.
