- 1.** The **petitioner, Saif Khan**, who is in custody since 23.03.2026, seeks bail in connection with **Patliputra P.S. Case No. 162 of 2026**, registered under Section 309(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS).
- 2.** According to the informant, Pankaj Kumar, who has been employed for approximately one year as a Cash Executive with Radiant Cash Management Service, Gola Road, his responsibility is to collect cash from various establishments in the Kurji More and Sai Mandir areas and deposit the same into the company's account after proper counting. On 23.03.2026, he collected cash from several outlets, including Domino's (Rs.75,240), V-Mart (Rs.1,29,090), Wow Momos (Rs.17,426), Structure Garments (Rs.4,12,191), and multiple shops located in P&M Mall such as Louis Philippe, Market 99, Credo, Cinepolis, Benetton India, Wow Momos, among others (Rs.16,000, Rs.5,800, Rs.4,645, etc.). He further collected Rs.3,28,049 from Reliance Trends near Sai Mandir and Rs.2,75,438 from Reliance Digital. The total cash collected amounted to Rs.19,53,182 (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Fifty-Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Two only). The entire amount was placed in a bag and kept in the dickey of his scooter (registration number BR-01HX1899). While proceeding via Patliputra Golambar, Alpana Market, and A.N. Path towards Central Bank, Boring Road, at around 3:30 PM near Pankaj Apartment on A.N. Path, two unidentified assailants on a Yamaha FZ motorcycle intercepted him. The pillion rider, brandishing a firearm, threatened him and forcibly took away the bag containing the cash. Simultaneously, two other accomplices on another motorcycle assisted in opening the scooter's dickey. All the culprits appeared to be between 25-30 years of age, with the one wielding the firearm

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having an orange-colored cloth (gamcha) wrapped around his face. Thus, the informant was robbed of Rs.19,53,182 at gunpoint.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only non-bailable offence alleged against him is under Section 309(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), which prescribes a maximum punishment of ten years' imprisonment. It is further submitted that the FIR was lodged against unknown persons, and the petitioner is not named therein. It is next submitted that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner asserts that he has been falsely implicated. He further fairly acknowledges that the petitioner has five criminal antecedents being (i) Singhul O.P. (Nagar Thana) in year 2019 (ii) Garhara P.S. Case No.451/2020 u/s 364-A, 120-B of IPC, (iii) Nagar Thana Begusarai P.S Case No.649/2020 under Arms Act, (iv) Chitragupt Nagar P.S. Case No.22 of 2026, (v) Barauni Thana Begusarai P.S Case No.640 of 2020 u/s 364(a) and other allied sections of IPC.
4. For better appreciation of this bail application, office is directed to **call for case diary** along with criminal antecedent of petitioner from the Investigating Officer.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to file supplementary affidavit with regard to para 3 of the bail application.
6. List this case on 24.06.2026.
