1. The present application for regular bail has been filed by **accused-petitioner, Monu Kumar**, who is in custody since 10.06.2026 in connection with **Ram Krishna Nagar P.S. Case No. 584/2026** dated 10.06.2026, registered under **Sections 61(2), 112 of BNS, Sections 8(c) and 21(c) of the NDPS Act, 25(1-B)(a), 26, 35 of Arms Act and Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amended Act, 2022.**
2. Heard Sri Santosh Kumar, learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and Sri Ashok Kumar Sinha, learned Spl. PP on behalf of the State.
3. The prosecution case, in brief, is that on the basis of credible secret information received on 09.05.2026 at about 8:30 PM, the police of Ramakrishnana-gar Police Station constituted a raiding team in the presence of a Magistrate and conducted a search at a rented premises, namely Room No. G-02, situated at Ghana Colony (Sorangpur), Patna. During the course of the search, **ap-proximately 10 kilograms of narcotic substances, including brown sugar and heroin**, were allegedly recovered, along with **two country-made illegal pistols with live cartridges**, drug-packaging materials, weighing machines, foreign liquor, mobile phones, and two motorcycles purportedly used for transporting contraband. The **petitioner, Monu Kumar, and co-accused Chintu Kumar were apprehended at the spot.** During interrogation, they

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allegedly disclosed the names of other co-accused, namely Santosh Sao @ Neeraj Sao @ Jitu Sao, Rekha Devi, Roshan Kumar, and Manish Kumar, indicating the existence of an organized syndicate engaged in procuring narcotic substances from Uttar Pradesh and distributing the same in Patna. The seized articles were duly inventoried in the presence of the Magistrate and witnesses, following which the accused persons were arrested and the present FIR was instituted under the aforesaid provisions of law.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated, contending that he has no involvement in the alleged activities. It was further argued that the mandatory provisions of the NDPS Act were not complied with during the course of investigation. It was also submitted that the petitioner has clean criminal antecedent, who has been in custody since 10.06.2026, and on these grounds, prayer for bail was made.
5. Per contra, the learned Special Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer for bail, submitting that a commercial quantity of narcotic substances, i.e., 10 kilograms of brown sugar and heroin, was recovered, along with illegal arms, cartridges, and other incriminating materials. It was further contended that the petitioner, along with co-accused persons, is part of an organized syndicate involved in trafficking narcotic drugs from Uttar Pradesh to Patna. It was also emphasized that the investigation is still ongoing and the charge-sheet has not yet been submitted. In view of the seriousness and gravity of the offence, it was urged that the bail application be rejected.

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6. Upon consideration of the nature and gravity of the allegations; **the recovery of commercial quantity of narcotic substances**; the submissions advanced on behalf of the State; the prima facie involvement of the petitioner in the alleged offence; and the fact that the investigation is still in progress and the charge-sheet has not yet been filed, this Court is of the considered opinion that the case is not fit for grant of regular bail.
7. Accordingly, the application for regular bail filed on behalf of the **petitioner, Monu Kumar**, stands **rejected**.
