ACJM XIII, Patna. On request of Ld. Counsel for the petitioners all nine petitions heard together.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners as well as the learned Addl.P.P. for the state.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed the offence as alleged in the FIR. The Ld. Counsel further contends that without any proper verification or expert inquiry police swept them into the massive investigation. An FIR was registered alleging hopping through 240 candidates under serious section of BNS and Bihar Examination Act, petitioners are a student their entire futures and careers on the line, if they were refused to let their hard-earned merit be ruined by a false accusation. So much so similarly situated co-accused persons namely Salim Kumar, Suman Kumar, Nilesh Kumar have already been granted anticipatory bail by the then court vide A.B.P. No.3169/2025 and 1222/2026. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. Hence the petitioners deserve to be released on anticipatory bail.

On the other hand learned Addl. P.P. opposed the bail prayer of the petitioners submitting that now the investigation against the petitioners is still pending.

Perused the case record. On perusal the case record it transpires that as per written report of the informant, during the verification and review the examination data base and record of the candidates, it was found that several candidates acted with dishonest intention to qualify in the aforesaid written examination or helped other to get qualifying in written examination through illegal financial transaction. In some case candidates appeared in the aforesaid examination multiple times and some impersonators were hired to get did appeared in the aforesaid examination or applied under two different name. With the help of the unknown criminals these candidate engaged in forgery, criminal conspiracy and fraud during the examination process to illegally secured government job.

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Heard both sides, perused the record, case-diary and other materials available on the case record. The allegation brought against the petitioners that they impersonating the others appeared two times in written examination of Constable Recruitment Advertisement No.01/2023 on the basis of forged certificate. It is also the fact that similarly situated co-accused persons namely Salim Kumar, Suman Kumar, Nilesh Kumar have already been granted anticipatory bail by the then court vide A.B.P. No.3169/2025 and 1222/2026.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances as well as the material available in the case diary and also seeing the nature of allegations as well as in the view of the argument advanced by the learned counsel for petitioner I am inclined to enlarge the all petitioners on anticipatory bail, in event of arrest or surrender of the all fourteen petitioners as above noted within six weeks from the date of receipt the copy of order, let the above noted all fourteen petitioners as above noted be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/ with two sureties like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.- XIII, Patna under subject to the condition as laid down under section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. 2023.
