**ORDER**

**18.03.2026**

1. The present Criminal Appeal has been preferred invoking the proviso of Section 413 of BNSS, by the informant-appellant against the impugned Judgment & Order dated 11.09.2025, passed in GR No. 472/2011 arising out of Dulhin Bazar P.S. Case No.29/2011, by Sri Pawan Kumar Chaudhary, learned Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Paliganj, whereby and whereunder, the learned trial Court has acquitted the accused persons of the charge framed under Section 380 and 457 of the Indian Penal Code,1860 (I.P.C.).
2. Case called out repeatedly. No one appeared on behalf of the informant-appellant. By perusal of the order-sheets, it is clear that since last several dates on repeated calls no one turned up on behalf of the informant-appellant. Vide order dated 26.02.2026, the informant-appellant was afforded last chance. It appears that informant-appellant has no interest to contest this case on merit. Accordingly, this criminal appeal is liable to be **dismissed** due to non-appearance of the informant-appellant.
3. It is, therefore, ordered that this criminal appeal is **dismissed**, due to continuous non-appearance on behalf of the informant-appellant.
