1 This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named accused-petitioners who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bihta P.S. Case No. 01/26, registered-U/S- 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 109, 351(2), 3(5) BNS.

2. Heard the Ld. Counsel for the applicant accused as well as the Ld. Public prosecutor for the state.

3. The applicant accused submitted that they are quite innocent and they have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. It is also submitted that no similar bail application is filed in this court or before the Hon'ble court. The applicant accused persons are ready to furnish sound surety.

4. During the course of hearing, case diary was called. Heard and perused the record. On perusal of the record, it is revealed that this case is registered on the basis of an application of the informant Ranjan Kumar wherein he stated that on 01.01.2026 at about 10:30 AM he got an informant that some of the persons and unscrupulous character cutting the road from JCB at Balughat and when the informant reached there they collectively assaulted him where Ajay Kumar assaulted with iron khanti which is sharp edged weapon by which he sustained injuries on his head and the applicant accused Abhay Singh assaulted with pistol on his head and then the informant fell down and Vikash Kumar, Ajay Kumar, Ranjan Kumar assaulted with an iron rod by which he sustained injury on his neck and chest and meanwhile Pappu Kumar, Mantu Kumar also assaulted him with an iron rod by which he sustained injury on his testicals Vikky Kumar tried to strangulate him and meanwhile his golden chain was also snatched. Rahul Kumar snatched rupees 70,000 from his pocket.

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5. On the other hand, the learned Addl. P. P. for the State opposed the prayer of bail.
6. During the course of hearing, the case diary was called. Heard and perused the record. On perusal of the record it appears that Investigating Officer (IO) recorded the further statement of the informant wherein he supported the allegation as levelled in the FIR. IO also recorded the statements of the witnesses Madan Kumar and Navin Kumar and they also supported the allegation as levelled in the FIR. IO mentioned in para No. 28 that he asked to the medical document from the informant but he made excuses and told him that no document and then IO give notice to the informant for producing the document relating to his statement as shown in para No. 33 but no alleged injury report is given. It appears that the informant did not give any such injury report to the IO in spite of the number of his request. IO submitted case diary upto para No. 40 dated 19.04.2026 but no injury report accompanied therein and no weapon allegedly used in the commission of the is recovered.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the applicant accused is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest/surrender within 30 days from the receipt of this order on furnishing the bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- along with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the condition as laid down U/S- 482(2) of BNSS and one of the surety of applicant accused persons shall be close relative and the applicant accused shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer. Let the copy of this order be sent to the court concerned.
