This regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of above named petitioner, who is in judicial custody since 02.12.2025 in connection with Rani Talab P.S. Case No. 111 of 2025 for the offence u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5) of B.N.S. during investigation later on I.O. has added Section 103(1) of B.N.S.

As per written application, allegation is that that petitioner along with other co-accused assaulted the informant and her father-in- law with bamboo stick and iron rod which caused serious head injury to informant's father-in - law and the all the accused threatened them of dire consequences and death if they lodge any case against them.

Apart from pleading innocence, false implication and clean antecedent the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that there is no direct and specific allegation against the petitioner. There is no eye witness of this case. B.P. No. 666/2025 has been filed on behalf of the other co-accused and same has been rejected on 01.08.2025. On the basis of these facts, it has been prayed that the petitioner may kindly be enlarged on bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. There is an allegation against the petitioner that he along with other co-accused have assaulted the informant's father in law Gopal Paswan leading to serious head injury and during the course of treatment he died. These injuries have been described in the inquest report as well as the postmortem report which is a part of the diary

and all the witnesses have supported these allegations during the statement recorded u/s 180 of BNSS. Supplementary investigation is still under progress. Bail of similarly circumstances co-accused Rajesh Choudhary has already been rejected by the court of Ld. A.S.J. I Danapur.

Therefore considering the seriousness and nature of the allegation against the petitioner, it would not be proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail accordingly his prayer stands **rejected**.
