**ORDER**

**06-04-2026**

The petitioners have filed the present anticipatory bail petition as they are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bikram P.S. Case No. 02/2026, registered U/Ss. 126(2), 117(2), 109, 351(2), 351(3) and 3(5) of the B.N.S., which is pending in the Ld. Court of A.C.J.M.-VI, Danapur.

The prosecution case, as per, the written-application of informant Ravi Kumar, S/o Dharmnath Yadav is that on 01/01/2026 at about 07:30 P.M., quarrel was going on at the house of Ravi Kumar, S/o Jainandan Yadav. In the meantime, the informant was going to his shop and the accused persons having lathi called the informant and brutally assaulted him due to which he sustained head injury and blood started oozing out. On the basis of written report of the informant, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation started.

The learned lawyer of the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence as alleged and the allegations levelled against them are totally false and baseless. Further earlier to this, the petitioners have not filed any bail application for grant of regular bail or anticipatory bail in this court or in the Hon'ble High Court. Petitioner No. 1 has had criminal antecedent of one case vide Bikram P.S. case no. 163/2012 and other petitioners have no criminal antecedents. There is case and counter case between the both parties and Bikram P.S. case no. 02/2026 is pending against the informant and others. There is no direct and specific allegation against the petitioners. The matter has been compromised between the parties and a Joint compromise petition attached with the record. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioners are ready to abide any condition or conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S.,

2023 and also ready to furnish bail-bond with proper sureties. So, the petitioners may be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

The learned Counsel for the informant is present in the court and supported the factum of compromise.

From perusal of part xerox copy of case diary and injury reports mentioned in it, it transpires that Doctor has found all injuries caused on the persons of the victims Ashnarayan Yadav and Ravi Kumar simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substances. Hence, it seems that the allegation U/S 109 of the B.N.S., seems to be super imposition in nature only to make out offences graver and non-bailable. Moreover, there is case and counter case between both sides and both sides have compromised the case. Accordingly, it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the concerned court within six weeks from the date of receipt of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each with condition laid down U/S 482(2) B.N.S.S., 2023 to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below. O/C is directed to send a copy of this order to the Ld. Trial Court and a copy of the same be uploaded in C.I.S.
