**01.** The petitioner **Kash Rai @ Ajay Kumar**, aged about 46 years, S/o Yamuna Rai, R/o Vill Alhanpura, P.S. Bihta, Dist Patna at present R/o Gulabibag, P.S. Maner, Dist Patna has filed the present anticipatory bail petition, as he is apprehending his arrest in connection with the present Bihta P.S. case no. 132/2015, dt. 25/02/2015, u/s 147, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307 of the I.P.C., which is pending before the court of A.C.J.M.-II, Danapur.

**02.** On 20/02/2026, an application to withdraw the pending bail application is filed by the learned lawyer of petitioner, who has submitted to withdraw the pending bail application because the petitioner has already filed A.B.P. No. 1683/2015 before the Sessions Judge, Patna, which was rejected vide order dated 02/04/2015 by the court of learned Sessions Judge, Patna and hence this bail petition is successive and second anticipatory bail application. It is therefore prayed to permit the petitioner to withdraw the pending bail application.

**03.** On perusal of entire materials on record, the court finds that this is a successive and second anticipatory bail application, which is not maintainable in the light of recent judicial pronouncement of the Hon'ble S.C. in G.R. Ananda Babu Vs. State of Tamil Nadu and Anrs reported in 2021 SCC On Line SC 176. Accordingly the present anticipatory bail application is **dismissed** as withdrawn with condition that the petitioner shall not file any other anticipatory bail application and he is directed to surrender in the lower court within 15 days from the date of this order. Office is directed to send copy of this order to concern court of A.C.J.M.- II, Danapur and also upload copy of order in the C.I.S.
