**ORDER**

**08-04-2026**

The petitioners have filed the present anticipatory bail petition as they are apprehending their arrest in connection with Ranitalab P.S. Case No. 215/2023, registered U/Ss. 341, 342, 448, 427, 436 and 354/34 of the I.P.C., which is pending in the Ld. Court of Sri Vinit Kumar Shah,, J.M.F.C., Danapur.

The prosecution case, as per written application of informant Ramesh Paswan is that, on 26/6/2023 in the morning hour, the son of Dadar Manjhi got an accident by an unknown tractor in front of the house of informant. The informant brought the injured from the road to his door. The F.I.R. named accused persons came there and started assaulting the informant. Thereafter, they entered into informant's house and started misbehaving with female family members. However, by the intervention of villagers, the matter was pacified. Further case is that in the evening, the above named accused persons again lashed with lathi, danda assaulted him. Thereafter, they put fire to the house of informant. The grains of wheat-5 quintals, rice - 6 quintal, mustard seed- 1 quintal all burnt in the fire. On the basis of written report of the informant, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation started.

The learned lawyer of the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence as alleged and the allegations levelled against them are totally false and baseless. Further earlier to this, the petitioners have not filed any bail application for grant of regular bail or anticipatory bail in this court or in the Hon'ble High Court and no bail application of the petitioners is pending in any court. The petitioners have no criminal

antecedents. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and nothing happened as per prosecution story. Both parties are own villagers and this case has been brought by the informant due to dirty village politics. There is no direct and specific allegation against the petitioners. The matter has been compromised between the parties and a joint compromise petition was filed before the Ld. Trial Court. Further other co-accused of this case has been granted bail from this court vide A.B.P. Nos. 2285/2024 and 2339/2024 and this case stands on similar footing. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioners are ready to abide any condition or conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023 and also ready to furnish bail-bond with proper sureties. So, the petitioners may be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioners.

From perusal of the record it transpires that the matter has been compromised between the parties and other co-accused persons were also granted bail from this court and this case stands on similar footing. Accordingly, it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the concerned court within 30 days from the date of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing of bail- bond of Rs.10,000/- with two surety of like amount each with condition laid down U/S 482(2) B.N.S.S., 2023 to the satisfaction of Ld. Court below. O/C is directed to send a copy of this order to the Court below and a copy of the same be uploaded in C.I.S.
