### **ORDER.**

**06-03-2026** This Regular Bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, who is in Judicial custody since 04-02-2026 in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 538 of 2021 registered under Sections 392 of the I.P.C., pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M.-VI, Danapur.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that earlier an A.B.P. No. 118 of 2026 was filed which was withdrawn on 11-02-2026 because the petitioner was arrested and after that this is the first regular bail application of the petitioner and no any bail petition of the petitioner is pending in any Court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no any offence. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and has been falsely implicated in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Krishna Kumar. None of the independent witnesses have been cited in the FIR and nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is also submitted that the co-accused Krishna Kumar and Saheban Kumar have been granted bail vide B.P. No. 2 of 2022 and B.P. No. 233 of 2022 respectively. The petitioner is ready to undertake that he will co-operate in the investigation/trial. The petitioner is in custody since 04-02-2026. Hence, he may be enlarged on bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the payer for bail.

As per F.I.R., on 14-10-2021, at 09:30 P.M., when the informant Sanjay Kumar Sudhanshu was going to drop the daughter of his brother-in-law by his Alto car, in the mid way, three bike borne miscreants riding on a Motor bike bearing Registration No. BR-01EU-4227 intercepted his car and on the point of pistol snatched the key of his car along with cash Rs. 10,000/-, A.T.M. Cards and other valuable documents of the informant along with a hand bag containing Rs. 5,000/-, two gold rings and mobile of the daughter of his brother-in-law and fled away.

It is submitted and disclosed on behalf of the petitioner that he is also an accused in Bikram P.S. Case No. 262 of 2021 and the case diary also shows the same.

Perused the case diary. On perusal of the same, it transpires that the prosecution

version finds support from it. It further transpires that the petitioner's name surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Krishna Kumar, who has already been granted bail by this Court vide B.P. No. 02 of 2022. There is nothing in the record except the confessional statement of co-accused Krishna Kumar to show his involvement in the alleged occurrence. The petitioner is in custody since 04-02-2026.

Having considered aforesaid including the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody of the petitioner, let the above named petitioner **Deepu Kumar**, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, subject to the conditions that :-

1. One of the bailors must be the resident of the native place of the accused-petitioner,
2. The petitioner shall not commit similar offence in future,
3. If at any stage of the case it is revealed to the Court concerned that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedents to obtain bail, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the learned Court concerned and
4. The petitioner shall fully co-operate in the investigation/trial of the case and shall be properly represented before the Court concerned.
