ORDER

12-03-2026

01. The regular bail petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is in custody since 30/12/2025 in connection with the present Shahpur P.S. Case No. 503/2025, dt. 30/12/2025, registered u/s 25 (1-B) (a), 26, 35 of the Arms Act, which is pending in the Court of S.D.J.M., Danapur.

02. The prosecution case, as per, the written-application of informant Ramkrishna Singh, S.I. of Shahpur P.S., in brief, is as such: That on 30/12/2025 at about 00:30 hrs, during vehicle checking at Sarari Gumati, a white color car was coming from Sarari. Seeing the police team, the driver accelerated the speed. The police team caught the car at Sarari ghunti. On asking, the accused persons told their names as Prince Kumar, Himanshu Kumar, Raushan Kumar and Guddu Kumar respectively. Then the police team started searching the car and recovered a desi pistol, 3 cartridges from the dashboard cabin. The accused persons could not produce any valid paper. Then police recovered mobile phones of the accused persons. The police seized all recovered items from the vehicle bearing registration no. BR01HC-3349 and accordingly a seizure list was made. On the basis of written report of the informant, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation started.

03. The learned lawyer of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged and the allegation leveled against him is totally false and baseless. Further that earlier no bail application either anticipatory or regular was filed either in this court or in the Hon'ble High Court by the petitioner. Further the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Further submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated merely on suspicion and local politics. Further no incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Further other co-accused of this case has been granted bail from this court vide B.P. no. 64/2026 dated 21/02/2026 and the case of petitioner stands on similar footing. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 30/12/2025 without any fault and is ready to execute bail bond as per direction of the court. So, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

04. The learned Addl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

05. Heard the Ld. Lawyers of the respective parties and perused the case record.

06. From perusal of the F.I.R., it appears that the present case has been lodged for the offence u/s 25 (1-B) (a), 26, 35 of the Arms Act for recovery of a desi pistol and three cartridge from a running vehicle and the petitioner was present in the vehicle. So far case diary is concerned, para 2 of the case diary contains the seizure list. Para 3 of the case diary contains the restatement of the informant. Para 4, 5 contain the statements of other witnesses. Para 18 of the case diary shows that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. On perusal of entire materials on record, the court finds that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 30/12/2025 in this case. Investigation of the case is pending. Further co-accused has been granted regular bail vide B.P. 64/2026.

07. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody of the petitioner and that the investigation of the case is pending, let the above named petitioner be **released on bail** on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned subject to the condition that **01.** the petitioner shall not commit similar offence in future, **02.** He shall fully co-operate in the investigation of the case and shall be properly representing before the court concerned.
