**ORDER**

**27-04-2026**

The regular bail petition has filed by the above named petitioner, who is in custody since 07/08/2025, in connection with Khagaul P.S. Case No. 256/2025, registered U/Ss. 126(2), 115(2), 109, 140(1), 61(1) and 3(5) of the B.N.S., which is pending in the Ld. Court of A.C.J.M.-V, Danapur.

The prosecution case, as per, the written-application of informant Badal Kumar, in brief, is as such: That on 05/08/2025 at about 07:30 o'clock, informant's elder brother namely Vishal Kumar had gone for the birthday party of his friend. Around 10:00 o'clock, the informant received a call that all the F.I.R. named accused persons along with some unknown persons are assaulting his brother at Chargarwa X-ing, Dalluchak. On getting information, the informant with his brother Nikhil Kumar reached there but could not find his brother. It is alleged that the accused persons assaulted and abducted his brother under conspiracy. On the basis of written report of the informant, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation started.

The learned lawyer of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent having clean criminal antecedent and committed no offence as alleged and the allegations levelled against him is totally false and baseless. The petitioner has not filed any bail petition before this court or in the Hon'ble High Court. The petitioner has not committed such offence and there is no cogent evidence against him. The police has arrested the petitioner on mere suspicion and remanded in this case for no fault. The petitioner was not present at the place of occurrence. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 07/08/2025 without any fault and is ready to execute bail bond as per direction of the court. So, the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

From perusal of the case trial court record it transpires that other co-accused persons namely Vishal Kumar @ Rider @ Gope Jee and Raushan Kumar regular bail petitions were rejected vide B.P. Nos. 1376/2025 and 1498/2025 respectively.

From perusal of case diary it transpires that the informant has stated the name of the petitioner/accused along with co-accused persons in his restatement before the police. Other witnesses have also stated the name of the petitioner/accused. From perusal of para 35 of the case diary it transpires that co-accused Ritesh Kumar @ Chhota Gel, on the basis of his statement dead body of deceased was recovered, has confessed the name of petitioner/accused as an accomplice in the aforesaid crime. Hence, considering the facts discussed above and gravity of the offence, I am not inclined to grant regular bail to the above named petitioner and the same is accordingly, **rejected**. O/ C is directed to send a copy of this order to the Ld. Trial Court and a copy of the same be uploaded in C.I.S.
