Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 498 of 2026

(Arising out of Shahpur P.S. Case No. 128 of 2025)

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner namely Mukesh Rai aged about 44 years son of Late Lobhi Rai apprehending his arrest in connection with Shahpur P.S. Case No. 128 of 2025 for the offence u/s 103(1), 3(5) of B.N.S.

Apart from pleading innocence and false implication, the Ld. counsel for the petitioner has admitted that the petitioner has got one criminal antecedent as Shahpur P.S. Case No. 303/2019. The petitioner has no connection at all the alleged incident of murder of the husband of the informant and there is no eye witness to support the allegation as alleged in the F.I.R. In the light of the above submissions, Ld. counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The learned A.P.P. for the State a vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard both sides and perused the record. The allegation in the F.I.R. relates to murder of the informant's husband Late Rajendra Rai. There is direct allegation against the petitioner and co-accused Anil Rai. In para 12, 18, 19, 20 of case diary, witnesses have supported the allegation. Investigation is still going on. The petitioner also bears three criminal antecedents.

Considering the seriousness of the offence, nature of allegation against petitioner and other facts discussed above, this court is not inclined to grant him on anticipatory bail. Hence, his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby **rejected**.
