ORDER

28-04-2026

The petitioner has filed the present anticipatory bail petition as he is apprehending his arrest in connection with Khirimore P.S. Case No. 08/2023, registered U/Ss. 379 and 420 of the I.P.C., which is pending in the then Ld. Court of Ms. Aishwarya Deep, J.M.F.C., Danapur.

The prosecution case, as per, the written-application of informant Nanhe Bind, in brief, is as such: That the informant is holder of account no. 71230100043146 in South Bihar Gramin Bank at Shankarpur Imamganj branch. On 09/12/2022, the informant withdrawn Rs. 3,000/- from his account from CSP Global Studio, Imamganj. Thereafter on 13/12/2022, total Rs.28,300/- has been illegally withdrawn from his account without his thumb impression and without his knowledge. On 07/01/2023 when the informant took print out of his passbook, he became aware of the deducted amount from his account. On the basis of written report of the informant, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation started.

The learned lawyer of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged and the allegations levelled against him is totally false and baseless. Further earlier to this, the petitioner has not filed any bail application for grant of regular bail or anticipatory bail in this court or in the Hon'ble High Court and no bail application of the petitioner is pending in any court. The petitioner has had criminal antecedent of six cases such as Paliganj P.S. Case no. 177/2025, Karpi P.S. Case no. 37/2015 and Kinjar P.S. Case nos. 15/2023, 16/2023, 17/2023 and 18/2023, in which he is on bail. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case with false allegation only with a view to harass in society. Petitioner's name came out in this case on confessional statement of other co-accused of this case. The alleged offences do not attract against the petitioner. Further the case has been compromised between the parties. The petitioner is a simple cultivator and has no concern with other co-accused persons.

Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide any condition or conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023 and also ready to furnish bail-bond with proper sureties. So, the petitioner may be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

The Ld. Counsel for defense in course of hearing has filed an order of the Hon'ble High Court passed in Cri. Misc. Case no. 20277/2026 dated 08/04/2026 in connection with the said case. From perusal of aforesaid order it transpires that the Hon'ble High Court has granted pre-arrest bail to the co-accused Raushan Kumar. The alleged sections are compoundable in nature. The case has been compromised with the petitioner/accused. Hence, considering the aforesaid facts, it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the concerned court within six weeks from the date of this order, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing of bail- bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each with condition laid down U/S 482(2) B.N.S.S., 2023 to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court.
