**ORDER**

**11-05-2026**

The petitioner has filed the present anticipatory bail petition as he is apprehending his arrest in connection with Ranitalab P.S. Case No. 276/2024, registered U/Ss. 331(4) and 76 of the B.N.S., which is pending in the then Ld. Court of Sri Vinit Kumar Shah, J.M.F.C., Danapur.

The prosecution case, as per, the written-application of informant Anita Devi, in brief, is as such: that on 17/01/2024 in midnight at about 12:00 P.M., the informant along with her daughter were sleeping in a room. In the meantime, petitioner/accused entered into her house and entered the room in which they were sleeping and hold the informant's daughter hand and tried to outrage her modesty. Over which, she started to make noise and on commotion, the petitioner/accused fled away from there. On the basis of written report of the informant, F.I.R. was lodged and investigation started.

The learned lawyer of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent having clean criminal antecedent and has committed no offence as alleged and the allegations levelled against him is totally false and baseless. Further earlier to this, the petitioner has not filed any bail application for grant of regular bail or anticipatory bail in this court or in the Hon'ble High Court and no bail application of the petitioner is pending in any court. It is submitted that prosecution story is false and concocted one. No such occurrence has ever took place and the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case with a view to harass. The petitioner neither entered the house nor harassed informant's daughter. The petitioner is a poor labourer and used to work in the field of informant and the informant did not pay the daily wages of petitioner/accused and for the same reason he left doing work and being anguished the informant lodged this false case. The alleged sections do not make out against the petitioner. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide any condition or conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023 and also ready to furnish bail-bond with proper sureties. So, the petitioner may be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

From perusal of Trial Court record including case diary it has transpired that the IO has submitted charge sheet against the petitioner/accused under Sections 331(4) and 76 of the B.N.S. and Cognizance has been taken against the petitioner/accused under the aforementioned Sections vide Order dated 21/07/2025. From perusal of para 27 of the case diary it transpires that petitioner/accused has given benefit U/S 35(1) of the B.N.S.S. From perusal of para 22 of the case diary it is evident that the petitioner/accused has clean criminal antecedent. Although there is direct allegations against the petitioner/accused regarding outrage modesty of the informant's daughter in night after entering into her house, but considering the facts that the petitioner/accused has been given benefit U/S 35(1) of the B.N.S.S., cognizance has already been taken and clean criminal antecedent, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner/accused on pre-arrest bail.

Accordingly, it is ordered that in the event of arrest or surrender before the concerned court within 30 days from the date of this order, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing of bail- bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each with condition laid down U/S 482(2) B.N.S.S., 2023 to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court.
