1. This anticipatory bail petition, filed on behalf of the above named applicant accused persons who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Khiri More P.S. Case No. 17/2026, lodged U/S- 105/3(5) BNS.
2. The applicant accused submitted that no previous bail application has filed before this court or before the Hon'ble court and he bears no previous criminal antecedents and it is further submitted that the applicant accused has falsely been implicated in this case due to village politics and previous enmity. It is further submitted that the applicant accused persons bear no criminal antecedent. The applicant accused persons are ready to furnish sound surety.
3. During the course of hearing, the case diary along with criminal history was called. On perusal of the record, it appears that this case is registered on the basis of an application of the informant Rambabu Kumar wherein he stated that his villagers Pravin Yadav, Munna @ Manish Kumar and Tuna @ Rahish Kumar fenced their field situated at Vala Bigha with live electric wire and were continuously supplying electricity 24 hours. As a result, two days prior to the occurrence, two nilgais, 4 jackals, and 2 dogs died after coming into contact with the electrified wire. Thereafter, on 17.06.2026 at about 03:00 PM, Raviraj Kumar @ Balveer went to see the dead animals at the place of occurrence he also came into contact with the live wire and died due to electrocution.
4. The learned Addl. P. P. for the State strongly opposed the anticipatory bail.

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5. During the course of hearing, the updated case diary was called. Heard and perused the record. On perusal of the record it appears that the Investigating Officer (IO) further recorded the statement of the informant in para No. 3 of the case diary. IO also recorded the statement of the witnesses Nitu Devi and Pintu Kumar, informant as well as the witnesses supported the allegation as levelled in the FIR. On perusal of the record it appears that deceased Raviraj Kumar @ Balveer, lost his life due to electrocution after coming into contact with the live electric wire allegedly installed by the applicant accused persons. It further appears that post-mortem report of the deceased attached with case diary which shows that the cause of death due to electrocution. FSL team also collected the nude metallic wire from the place of occurrence of Bala Bigha. Thus the materials collected during the investigation disclose the prima facie evidence connecting the applicant accused persons with the alleged occurrence.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances, and the gravity of the offence, the death of the a human being as well as animals due to electrocution, this court is not inclined to enlarge the applicant accused on bail. Consequently, this bail application is hereby **dismissed**. Let the copy of this order be sent to the court concerned.
