1 This anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of above named accused-petitioners who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 236 of 2021, registered- U/S- 147/341/323/324/325/307379/387 IPC.

2. Heard the Ld. Counsel for the applicant accused as well as the Ld. Public prosecutor for the state.

3. The applicant accused submitted that they are quite innocent and they have not committed any offence and they have falsely been implicated in this case. It is also submitted that no similar bail application is filed in this court or before the Hon'ble court. It is further submitted that the applicant accused persons bear no criminal antecedent and there is no ingredient of any criminal offence against the petitioners. Besides it, there is no material or evidence available on case record against against the petitioners to connect in this case. The applicant accused persons are ready to furnish sound surety.

4. During the course of hearing, case diary was called. Heard and perused the record. On perusal of the record, it is revealed that this case is registered on the basis of fardbyan of the informant Jaleshwar wherein he stated that on 08.03.2021, he was loading potatoes on the tractor in his field and meanwhile Pataiya, Pankaj Kumar and Vishal told the informant on the point of pistol as to who give their expanses upon which them intimated him to

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deliver one lakhs rupees within an hour and thereafter, his loaded potatoes would be transported and thereafter, in the night at about 07:45 PM the said persons along with other persons Chandan Kumar, Amir Lal Ram 10-15 unknown persons came to the informant and they abused him and started beating with stick and rod and meanwhile the s/o Amir Lal Rai who was having a knife assaulted on the face of the informant with knife by which he sustained injuries near his eyes. Pataiya assaulted on his head with an iron rod by which he sustained injury on his head and thereafter, they snatched rupees 70,000 obtained by the informant from the sale of his potatoes and thereafter, on hearing his screaming his son arrived at the spot and tried to rescue him and then the accused persons also assaulted him with stick, rod, fists and legs and they further intimidated that if the informant could cultivated the land here, he have to obey and to pay their extortinated demand failing which he would be killed. Thereafter, the local persons removed the injured person to PHC, Maner from where he was referred to PMCH for better treatment.

5. On the other hand, the learned Addl. P. P. for the State opposed the prayer of bail.

6. Heard and perused the record. On perusal of the record it appears that Investigating Officer (IO) recorded the further statement of the informant in case diary para No. 6 of the case diary and thereafter, he inspected the place of occurrence and para No. 8 and then recorded the statement of the witnesses Raj Kishore Yadav, Mithlesh Kumar Rai, Manohar Lal as shown in para No. 9, 10 and 11 of the case diary and they supported the allegation as levelled in FIR. In para No. 54 it is shown that the applicant accused Pankaj Kumar and Vishal Kumar have no previous criminal antecedent registered in the police station Maner. In para No. 65 and 66, IO recorded the statement of the independent witnesses Vipan Ram and Shamdev Paswan they also stated in their statement the applicant accused Pankaj Kumar, Vishal Kumar along with other accused persons committing marpit with the informant and blood was oozing out from the body of the injured informant. In para No. 72 of the case diary collectively shows that on C.T. Scan report no fracture was seen in the hand and the injury was simple. Moreover, the allegation of

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causing with the knife and the rod was not on the applicant accused persons and in regard snatching of the rupees 70,000 from the possession of the accused. None of the witnesses whose statement was recorded during the investigation including the Raj Kishore Yadav who is the son of the informant stated about the snatching of rupees 70,000.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the applicant accused persons are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest/surrender within 30 days from the receipt of this order on furnishing the bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- along with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the condition as laid down U/S- 482(2) of BNSS and one of the surety of applicant accused persons shall be close relative and the applicant accused shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer. Let the copy of this order be sent to the court concerned.
