ORDER.

13-08-2026 The Anticipatory Bail petition No. 982 of 2026 and A.B.P. No. 1230 of 2026 arise out of same Maner P.S. Case No. 138 of 2022 and thus the same are being disposed of by this common order.

These Anticipatory Bail petition have been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, who apprehend their arrest in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 138 of 2022 registered under Sections 363, 365 read with 34 of the I.P.C.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Apart from pleading innocence and false implication, learned counsel for the petitioners commonly submitted that they are also an accused in Maner P.S. Case No. 429 of 2024, in which they are on bail. It is further commonly submitted that the allegation against the petitioners are general and omnibus in nature and there is a delay of about two months and 10 days in lodging the FIR and no explanation of delay has been given. It is further submitted that there is a land dispute between the parties and their names have been implicated in case due to local politics. In the light of the above submissions, learned counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the payer for bail.

Perused the record along with the case diary. There is allegation against the petitioners that they kidnapped the informant's son. In para 4, 5 & 6 of the case diary, witnesses have also supported these allegations. It further transpires that the informant's son has not recovered as yet. The investigation in the case is still pending.

Therefore, in the light of these facts, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of Anticipatory Bail to these petitioners. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners **Munarik Ray and Lalji Kumar**, is hereby **rejected**.
