ORDER.

26-05-2026 This Regular Bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, who is in Judicial custody since 21-04-2026, in connection with Maner P.S. Case No. 361 of 2026, registered under Sections 25(1-B)(a), 35 of Arms Act, pending in the Court of Md. Arbaz Ansari, learned J.M.-Ist Class, Danapur.

Apart from pleading innocence, false implication, clean antecedents and this to be the first bail application of this petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation labeled against the petitioner is totally false and baseless. Neither the arms nor any other illegal articles has been recovered from the petitioner. It is further submitted that the alleged arms was found in the pocket of the accused Sahil Kumar and the petitioner has no knowledge regarding it. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 21-04-2026. Hence, he may be enlarged on bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the payer for bail.

Perused the case diary. On perusal, it transpires that there is no recovery of any fire arms or ammunition from the possession of this petitioner. He also bears clean antecedents as per para 23 of the case diary. He has remained in judicial custody since 21-04-2026 yet the I.O. did not choose to take him on police remand. This suggest that there is no requirement of his further incarceration.

Therefore, considering all these facts and the period of custody of the petitioner and his clean antecedents, let the above named petitioner **Vicky Kumar**, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned **with a condition that he shall remain physically present in the trial Court on each and every date till framing of the charge.**
