ORDER.

26-05-2026 This Regular Bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, who are in Judicial custody since 27-04-2026 in connection with Piplawan P.S. Case No. 70 of 2026 registered under Sections 191(2), 190, 115(2), 121(2), 122(2), 132, 109(1), 3(5) of the B.N.S., pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M.-IV, Danapur.

Apart from pleading innocence, false implication, clean antecedents and this to be the first bail application of these petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no incriminating articles has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners and they have no concerns with the alleged crime. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 27-04-2026. Hence, this prayer for bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the payer for bail.

Perused the case diary. On perusal, it transpires that the Injury Report annexed with the case diary shows the nature of injury to be simple. The allegation appears to be general and omnibus and as per para 26 of the case diary, these petitioners have got clean antecedents. Petitioners are in judicial custody since 27-04-2026 and the I.O. did not choose to take them on police remand. Similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail by this Court in B.P. No. 560 of 2026.

Therefore, considering all these facts and the period of custody of the petitioners and their clean antecedents, let the above named petitioners **Shiv Prasad Ravidas and Chandan Kumar**, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned **with a condition that they shall remain physically present in the trial Court and co-operate with the trial.**
