29-06-2026 This Anticipatory Bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, who is apprehending her arrest in connection with Danapur P.S. Case No. 1264 of 2024 registered under Sections 303(2) of the B.N.S., pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M.-I, Danapur.

Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Apart from pleading innocence, false implication, clean antecedents and this to be the first bail application of the petitioner, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that no recovery has been effected from the possession of the petitioner and there is no specific allegation against her. The petitioner is a girl and she is ready to abide by all the conditions imposed against her by the learned Court. In the light of the above submissions, Ld. counsel prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the record. On perusal, it transpires that the FIR relates to the allegation of theft. Case diary is available in the record. In the entire case diary there is no mention, at all about, this petitioner. The investigation has been completed in this case and the charge-sheet has also been submitted by the I.O. of the case. Thus, I do not find that the petitioner is under any real apprehension of arrest in this case. The perception of petitioner regarding possibility of her arrest in future appears to be imaginary at this stage.

Therefore, this Anticipatory Bail is **dismissed as not maintainable**. However, the petitioner will be at liberty to file the anticipatory bail petition afresh, if there arises any reasonable or real apprehension of arrest to her in future.
