ORDER.

09-07-2026 This Regular Bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, who is in Judicial custody since 12-05-2026, in connection with Bikram P.S. Case No. 208 of 2026 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 303(2), 351(2), 351(3), 352, 3(5) B.N.S., pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M.- VI, Danapur.

Apart from pleading innocence, false implication and clean antecedents, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that this present case has been lodged against the petitioner to save from Bihta P.S. Case No. 207 of 2026. It is further submitted that all the alleged Sections are not applicable against this petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 12-05-2026. Hence, it is prayed that he may be enlarged on bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the payer for bail.

Perused the record. On perusal, it transpires that all the injury sustained by the victims are in the nature of swelling, abrasion and lacerated wound, which are simple in nature and caused by hard and blunt substance. The petitioner also bears clean antecedents and there also exists a counter case against the informant lodged by one of the accused which is registered as Bikram P.S. Case No. 207 of 2026. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted photocopy of the treatment documents of the petitioner to show that the petitioner has been also been assaulted by the informant and his family members. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 12-05-2026.

Therefore, in the light of above said facts petitioner is enlarged upon bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned **subject to the condition that he shall remain physically present on each and every date till framing of the charge. However, the bail bond shall be accepted after completion of the investigation against this petitioner.**
