Order on Sentence

Present:- The Convict LAXMAN S/O SAO(A1 in J/C alongwith his Ld. Counsel Sri Pramod Ranjan, Ld. Advocate. Md. Kalam Ansari, Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor for the state.

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convict but this case is of committing the offence of dowry death for the want dowry which is a social evil punishable under law and it is therefore considering the submissions and having regard to the age of the convict, nature of the offence as well as the gravity of the offences and all the such issues as raised and to find the ends of justice, I award punishment to the convict Laxman Sao(A1) for the offence punishable under section 304B IPC as-----

the convict Laxman Sao(A1) is sentenced for Rigorous imprisonment of 10 (Ten) Years

The benefit of section 428 Cr.p.c shall be given to the convict

I also recommend that appropriate compensation, under section 357-A, Cr.P.C/u/s 396 BNSS be awarded to the victim identified as the father of the deceased Shobha Devi and he is the informant Manohar Sao s/o Late Collector Sao, R/O Vill. Sadisopur, P.S. Bihta, District-Patna, and hence a copy of the judgment as well as the order of sentence be sent to the Secretary, District Legal Service Authority, Patna, for deciding the quantum of compensation to be awarded under the victim compensation scheme as referred under section 357A, Cr.P.C/u/s 396 BNSS
