1. This anticipatory bail petition, filed on behalf of the above named applicant accused persons who is in judicial custody since 15.06.2026 arrest in connection with Khiri More P.S. Case No. 17/2026, lodged U/S- 105/3(5) BNS.
2. The applicant accused submitted that no previous regular bail application has filed before this court or before the Hon'ble court and he bears no previous criminal antecedents and it is further submitted that the applicant accused has falsely been implicated in this case due to village politics and previous enmity. It is further submitted that the anticipatory bail application of the applicant accused was dismissed by this court. The applicant accused is in judicial custody 15.06.2026 and he is ready to furnish sound surety.
3. During the course of hearing, the case diary along with criminal history was called. On perusal of the record, it appears that this case is registered on the basis of an application of the informant Rambabu Kumar wherein he stated that his villagers Pravin Yadav, Munna @ Manish Kumar and Tuna @ Rahish Kumar fenced their field situated at Vala Bigha with live electric wire and were continuously supplying electricity 24 hours. As a result, two days prior to the occurrence, two nilgais, 4 jackals, and 2 dogs died after coming into contact with the electrified wire. Thereafter, on 17.06.2026 at about 03:00 PM, Raviraj Kumar @ Balveer went to see the dead animals at the place of occurrence he also came into contact with the live wire and died due to electrocution.
4. The learned Addl. P. P. for the State strongly opposed the regular bail.

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5. During the course of hearing, the updated case diary was called. Heard and perused the record. On perusal of the updated case diary, it appears that the Investigating Officer (IO) has recorded the statements of the informant and the witnesses, who have supported the allegations made in the FIR. It further appears that the deceased Raviraj Kumar @ Balveer died due to electrocution after coming into contact with the live electric wire allegedly installed around the agricultural field. The post-mortem report also opines that the cause of death was electrocution. The FSL team has also collected the metallic wire from the place of occurrence. However, it also appears from the para No. 17 of the case diary, the petitioner is a student and resides outside his native village for pursuing his studies. It further appears from paragraph no. 90 of the case diary that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The IO did not require the applicant accused for custodial interrogation since 15.06.2026. However, the prayer of anticipatory bail of the applicant accused was dismissed by this court but now the applicant accused has come in regular bail and he is in judicial custody since 15.06.2026.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances, period of custody and clean antecedent the applicant accused is ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- along with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to condition 480(3) BNSS and one of the surety of applicant accused shall be close relative and the applicant accused shall join the investigation as and when directed by the IO. Let the copy of this order be sent to the court concerned.
