ORDER

05.08.2026	1. This anticipatory bail petition, filed on behalf of the above named accused-petitioner who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 463/2026, lodged U/S- 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 281 3(5) BNS. 2. The prosecution story, in short, is that on 16.06.2026 at about 09:00 PM, informant Mayank Kumar was returning home on his motorcycle meanwhile a vehicle bearing reg. No. BR01JC6306 pushed his motorcycle. When he objected then he started abusing him and thereafter he called his two friends and assaulted him with iron rod with intention to kill him in which he sustained injuries and fell down. Thereafter, some person took him to the hospital. Thereafter, he came to know that Golu Kumar @ Shivam pushed his motorcycle and he did not know about his friends. 3. After placing the innocence and false implication of the petitioner, the learned defence counsel submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offences as alleged in the case. It is further submitted that there is a case and counter case between the parties. The petitioners bear clean antecedent. The petitioners are man of means the they are ready to furnish bail bonds. Hence, they prayed that the petitioners may be granted Anticipatory bail. 4. The learned Addl. P. P. for the State opposed the prayer of Anticipatory bail. 5. Heard both the parties at length. It transpires that the allegation against the petitioners is intentionally hit the informant with a vehicle and	Contd.

Counsel of the petitioner submit a copy of FIR which shows that there is case and counter case in between the parties. Both case and counter case suggest that an occurrence of assault took place in between the parties for a hit of vehicle and no deadly weapon used in the occurrence and petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Considering the facts and circumstances discussed above, clean criminal antecedent of the petitioner and occurrence took place for the dispute of driving of a motorcycle, the Anticipatory Bail filed on behalf of the petitioner is allowed. The petitioners are in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within 30 days from the receipt of this order, the petitioners, shall be released on bail on a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of ACJM- VI, Danapur.
