30-06-2026. This Anticipatory Bail Petition has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, who apprehends his arrest in connection Complaint Case No. 162(C) of 2013 wherein cognizance has been taken under Section 420 of the I.P.C., pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M.-VI, Danapur.

Case called out, but on repeated call no body appear to press the instant A.B.P. filed on behalf of the aforesaid petitioner. This A.B.P. was filed on 17-09-2025 and since then pending for hearing. Learned counsel for the petitioner repeatedly directed to press the A.B.P. filed on behalf of the aforesaid petitioner and vide order dated 24-03-2026 last chance was also given to press the A.B.P. but all in vain.
