1. A petition dated **03/01/2026** for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of above named **sole** petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Complaint Case No. 530 (C) of 2025**, for the alleged have committed offences punishable u/s 77, 126(2) BNS & 67 IT Act, *pressed today*. A copy of bail petition has already been served to the Ld. APP.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP), appearing on behalf of the State.

3. Prosecution case, *in brief*, as per complaint petition of Savita Devi, is that on 21/08/2025 at 04:00 AM, she went for natural call in the meantime, Sunny Kumar caught hold her. On protest, he thrashed her on the ground. Sunny Kumar tide her mouth with *Gamchha* & started abusing her. He also threatened to kill her, she does not act as per his wish. Sunny Kumar has also uploaded obscene photographs on internet.

4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioner that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court and petitioner has **no** criminal antecedent. Petitioner is quite innocent & committed no offence. The petitioner is not mobile holder to the screen tough so there is no chance & viral video, so 66 IT Act is not applicable against the petitioner. Petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Ld. A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer of petitioner for anticipatory bail.

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R) & Case Diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is allegation against accused petitioner that he has tried to molest complainant & made her obscene photographs viral on the internet. Complainant during her S.A. before the Court submitted that petitioner has tried to molest her. Further, during Court question, she stated that her husband has taken Rs. 10 thousand loan from petitioner Sunny Kumar. She further stated that Sunny Kumar has made her obscene video by showing something to her, due to which, she became unconscious. Complainant has also submitted *pen-drive* in which alleged video is stored. From perusal of video, it transpires that she is happily & willingly having chat with petitioner and also showing her body to him. Further, complainant has not given any details of the website on which, petitioner has made her video viral. Complainant is a major lady. It seems that due to dispute of money taken by her husband from petitioner, she has made this false complaint against petitioner. This case is based on private complaint.


7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, prayer of anticipatory bail of above named **complainant** is **hereby allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Ld. Trial Court **within four weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order**, petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C. **(i) One of the bailor shall be family member/close relatives**. Let the copy of this order be sent to the concerned Trial Court.
