ORDER

This case has been instituted on the basis of fard beyan of informant, who alleged that on 27.08.1992 at around 05:50 P.M. when he was on his shop then the four miscreants entered his shop and thereafter one of miscreants took out the gun and pointed at him and looted articles and cash from his shop and fled away. It is further alleged that name of the miscreant, who pointed gun at him, was Manoj Kumar and the other who took out the cash from his cash box was Pankaj and his other two associates could not be identified by the him. Subsequently, FIR was registered.

After completion of investigation, the police has submitted charge sheet against the accused namely Manoj Kumar u/s- **392, 411, 307 of the I.P.C. and 27, 25 (1-b) (A), 26, 35 Arms Act.** vide charge sheet no.- 212/1993, dated 30.11.1993.

On 06.08.1994, Ld. A.C.J.M., Barh (Patna), considering the materials available on record, has taken cognizance against the accused namely Manoj Kumar for the offences u/s- **392, 411, 307 of the I.P.C. and 27, 25 (1-b)(A), 26, 35 Arms Act.**

Subsequently, case record of the accused Manoj Kumar has been committed to the Court of Sessions on 23.08.2004 for trial and disposal.

On 24.02.2010, charge has been framed against accused Manoj Kumar **u/s.- 392, 411, 307 of the I.P.C. and 27, 25 (1-b)(A), 26, 35 Arms Act.** Thereafter, prosecution has been given a sufficient opportunity to adduce evidence but even after lapse of more than 16 years, not even single witness has been produced by the prosecution in support of his case. Consequently, prosecution evidence was closed on 11.06.2026 after giving sufficient opportunity to prosecution to adduce evidence.

After closure of prosecution evidence, case is fixed for judgment on 23.06.2026.

In the light of above stated facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that the prosecution miserably failed to adduce evidence in order to prove the charges leveled against the accused **Manoj Kumar U/sec.- 392, 411, 307 of the I.P.C. and 27, 25 (1-b)(A), 26, 35 Arms Act.** Therefore, the accused Manoj Kumar is hereby acquitted from all the charges leveled against him. Accordingly, he and his sureties are discharged from the liability of bail bonds. He is set at liberty.
