

**In the Court of Additional Sessions Judge-V, Barh.**

**S.Tr. No. 122 of 2019.**

The bail petition on behalf of the custody accused Vikramaditya Paswan has been filed on 16.04.2019 which was moved today by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Vide Paragraph 2 of the bail petition. It has been mentioned that the learned Hon'ble High Court has been pleased to reject the bail petition of this petitioner vide Criminal Miscellaneous No. 21294 of 2018 dated 28.06.2018. It has also been submitted that at time investigation was pending the learned counsel submitted that accused is innocent and has committed no offence. In-charge learned A.P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the bail of the petitioner has already been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court and in this case after submission of charge-sheet under Section 364A the case has been committed for trial. The case is pending for framing of the charge against the accused persons. Today was date fixed for framing of charge but one of the accused, namely, Shanu has done his parvi through his learned counsel under Section 370 of the Cr.P.C. He has been warned to be present on the next date, failing which the privilege of bail may be cancelled.

Perused the case record in the instance case charge-sheet has been submitted under Section 364A of the IPC and considering the seriousness of the offence and also keeping in view the complexity of the present

petitioner the Hon'ble High Court has already rejected the prayer for bail of this petitioner. On such circumstance I am not inclined to give this petitioner privilege of bail at this stage. Hence, the petition dated 16.04.2019 hereby dismissed.
