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ORDER

1. The anticipatory bail application has been filed on the behalf of the petitioner **Amarjeet Das @ Amarjeet Kumar** , who is apprehending arrest in connection with **Barh P.S. Case No. 156 of 2026** registered *u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 303(2), 324(4), 352, 351(2) & 3(5) of BNS.*

2. Heard the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and the Ld. APP for the state.

3. As per the prosecution case the petitioner along with other co-accused came to the house of informant and started abusing him and thereafter entered the house by breaking open the door. Informant further alleged that she was assaulted and misbehaved by accused persons. Then, Vinod Kumar Das snatched her chain and took away Rs. 2000/- and further threatened to kill her son. Subsequently, FIR was registered.

4. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due in the backdrop of land dispute between the parties. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against this petitioner. Hence, prays for privilege of bail to the accused petitioner.

5. The Ld. APP opposed the prayer of bail.

6. Heard both the sides and perused the case record. From the perusal of case record, it transpires that witnesses in their statement U/sec. 161 of the Cr.P.C, stated about ongoing land dispute between the parties. It further transpires that allegation against this petitioner is general and omnibus in nature. Furthermore, the injury report of the victim is not a part of this case diary nor made available to this court during the course of hearing. Moreover, this petitioner has clean antecedent as per para-3 of the bail petition.

In the light of aforesaid facts, let the petitioner namely **Amarjeet Das @ Amarjeet Kumar** be released on bail in event of arrest or surrender before the court within period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order on furnishing bail bond Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court, subject to the conditions as specified u/s 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
