1. A petition dated **16/05/2026**, for grant of anticipatory bail filed on behalf of above named accused petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Bhadaur P.S. Case No. 68 of 2026**, for the alleged have committed offences punishable u/s 115(2), 126(2), 109, 352, 351(2) r/w 3(5) BNS, pressed today. A copy of bail petition has already been served to the Ld. APP.

2. Heard, Ld. Counsel for the petitioners as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor (APP), appearing on behalf of the State.

3. Prosecution case, in brief, as per written report of informant, **Sanjit Mochi** is that on 06/05/2026 at 07:00 PM, Harikant Ravidas, Manju Devi & their two sons Chandan Ravidas & Mithun Ravidas abused & misbehaved with his wife and father. On protest, they assaulted him and his wife and father with iron-rod, due to which, they sustained injury.

4. At Para- 2 & 3 of the bail petition, certificate has been given by petitioners that earlier no regular or anticipatory bail either before Ld. Court of Sessions or before Hon'ble High Court has been filed, nor any bail application is pending before any Court. Petitioner has criminal antecedent. The case has been compromised between the parties and has been filed with permission to compromise the case in lower Court. There is no case made out u/s 109 BNS and other sections are bailable in nature. Petitioners are ready to furnish bail bond with sound sureties & obey each and every conditions imposed by Court, if bail is granted.

5. Ld. A.P.P. appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer of petitioners for anticipatory bail. **Cont'd.../-**

6. Trial Court Record (T.C.R) & Case Diary (CD) have been received. Heard, rival contentions of both the parties and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that there is allegation against accused petitioner that they alongwith other co-accused persons have abused & assaulted informant and his family member, due to which, they sustained injuries. Both parties have compromised this case and filed joint compromise petition. Informant and victims are present in the Court & accepted the factum of compromise. They also submitted that they sustained injury due to falling down. As per injury report attached with CD, Neelam Devi sustained injury on forearm. Basant Mochi & Sanjit Mochi sustained injury on head. **Co-accused persons have already been granted by this Court vide order dated 09/06/2026 passed in BP No. 285/2026.**

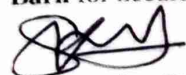
7. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, nature of allegation, **prayer of anticipatory bail** of all above named petitioners, are **hereby allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Trial Court **within four weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order**, petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties** of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court, subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS. **Further condition that (a) One of the Bailor shall be family member/close relative, (b) They will co-operate in the investigation of this case & (c) Not to involve in such type of occurrence in future.** It is, however, clarified that the observations made herein are limited to the adjudication of the present bail application and shall not prejudice the case of the petitioners at any subsequent stage of the investigation/trial and this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
